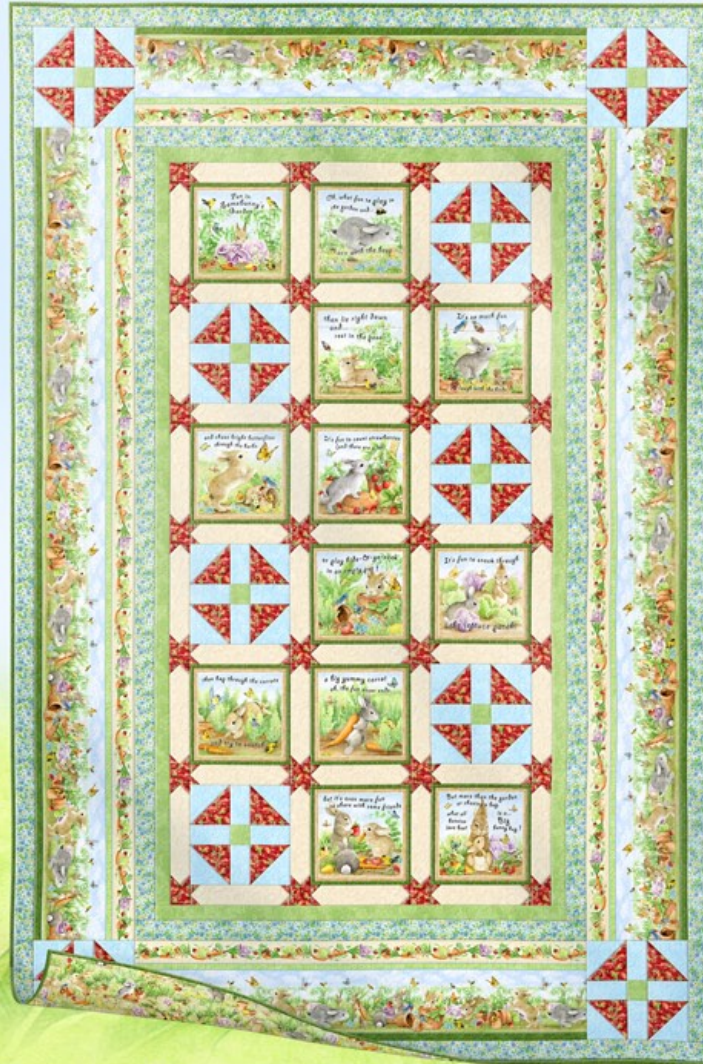

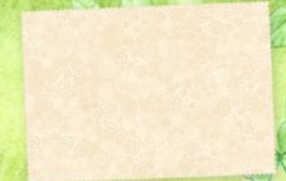

# Somebunny's Garden

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - \*\* cut 12 - 9 3/4" x 9 3/4" squares (center designs evenly)

**Fabric B** - cut lengthwise: cut 2 - 9 3/4" x 81 1/2" and 2 - 9 3/4" x 45 1/2"

**Fabric D** - cut 3 - 4 7/8" strips, subcut 20 - 4 7/8" squares  
Sashing: cut 2 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 28 - 2 1/2" squares  
cut 7 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 180 - 1 1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - Borders - cut 16 - 2 1/2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip, then subcut:

2 - 2 1/2" x 77 1/2"

2 - 2 1/2" x 45 1/2"

2 - 2 1/2" x 101 1/2"

2 - 2 1/2" x 69 1/2"

**Fabric F** - Sashing - cut 3 - 10 1/2" strips, subcut 45 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"

**Fabric G** - cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut 10 - 2 1/2" squares  
Borders - cut 6 - 2" strips, sew end to end, then subcut 2 - 2" x 74 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 41 1/2"

**Fabric H** - cut 3 - 4 7/8" strips, subcut 20 - 4 7/8" squares  
cut 5 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 40 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

**Fabric I** - \*\*cut 12 - 7/8" strips, subcut 24 - 7/8" x 9 3/4" and 24 - 7/8" x 10 1/2"

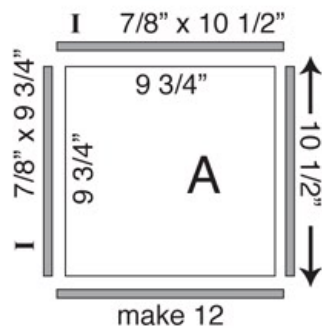
cut 7 - 1 1/4" strips, sew end to end then subcut

2 - 1 1/4" x 81 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/4" x 45 1/2"

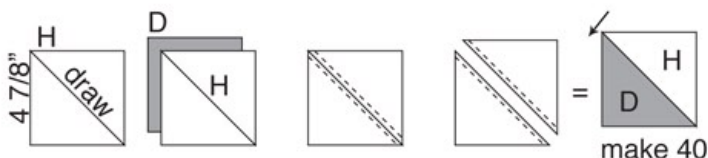
**BINDING** - cut 9 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

## 2. Piecing Order:

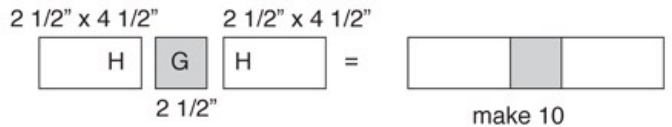
- Sew **I** 7/8" borders around 12 **A** 9 3/4" squares, sides first, then top and bottom borders. \*\* (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **I** borders slightly larger, sew around **A** squares, then trim all blocks to measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2".)



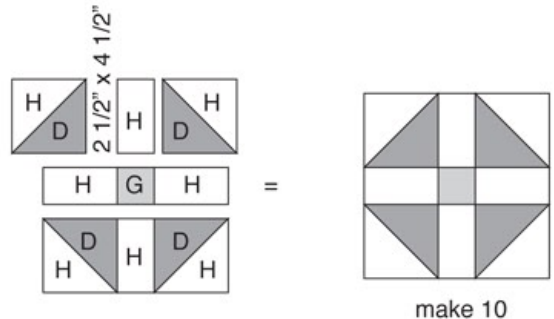
- Make 10 - 10" finished (10 1/2" unf.) Pieced Blocks. First, make 40 - 4" finished (4 1/2" unf.) **H/D** half square triangle units. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of 20 **H** 4 7/8" squares. Pair each **H** square with a **D** 4 7/8" square, right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the diagonal line. Cut on the line to separate units. Press toward **D** for 40 units.



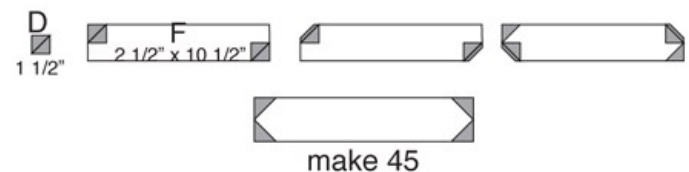
Next, sew two **H** 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" and one **G** 2 1/2" square together for the middle row for 10 blocks according to the diagram.



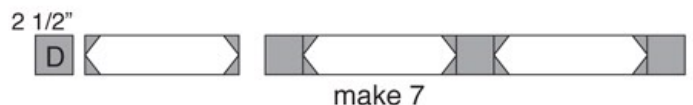
Sew one **H** 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" and two **H/D** half square triangles together for the top and bottom rows. Then sew rows together according to the diagram.



- Make 45 - 2" x 10" finished (2 1/2" x 10 1/2" unf.) pieced sashing strips. First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 180 **D** 1 1/2" squares. Place a **D** square over two opposite corners of **F** 2 1/2" x 10 1/2", right sides together and match raw edges. Pay attention to the direction of the diagonal line according to the diagram. Stitch ON the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from seam and press triangle outward. Repeat with remaining corners for 45 sashing strips.



Next, sew 7 rows of Sashing, each consisting of three sashing strips and 4 **D** 2 1/2" squares.



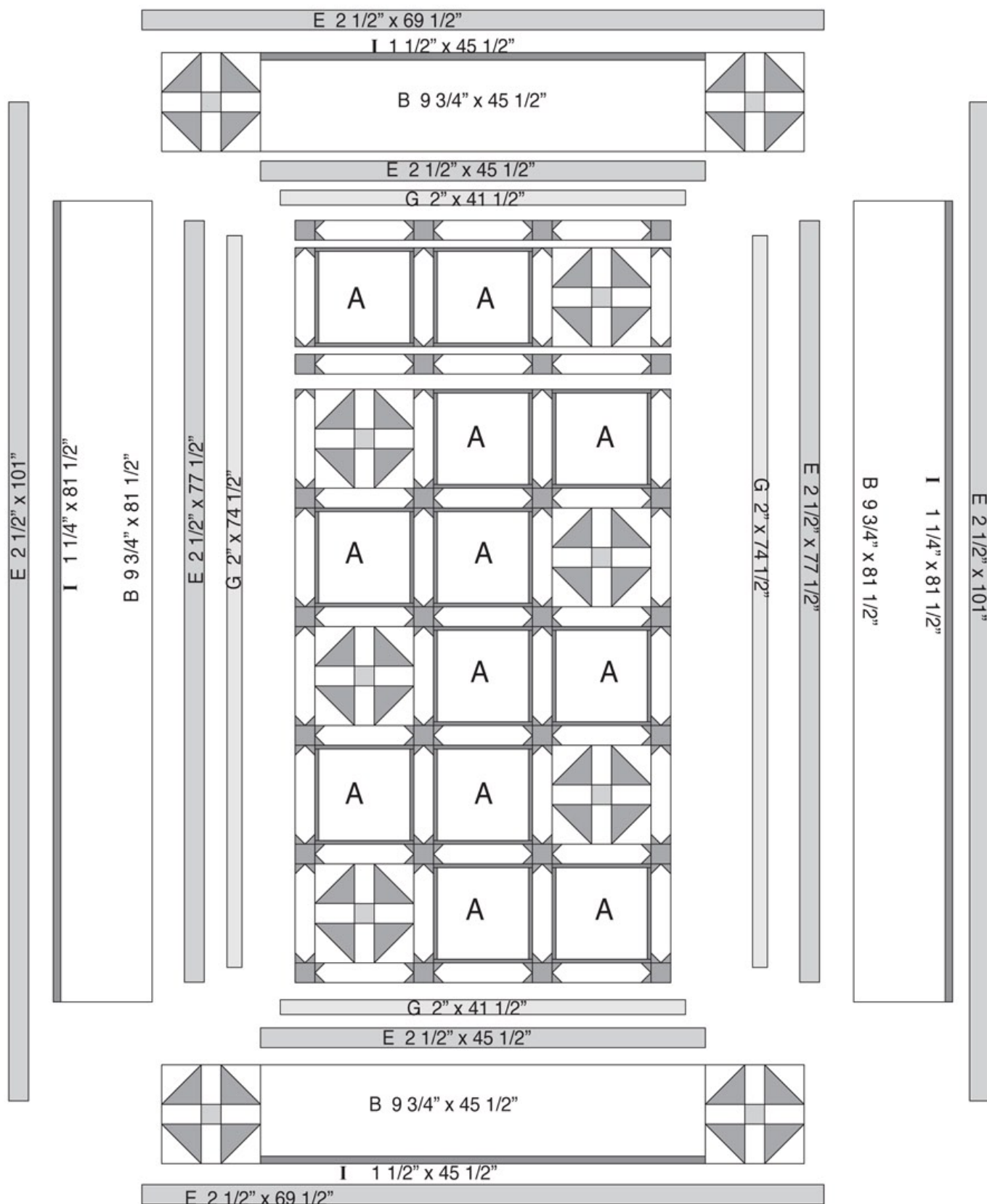
- Sew rows of **A** Blocks and Pieced Blocks alternating Sashing Strips according to the diagram on the next page.

Next, sew rows of blocks alternating rows of sashing strips together according to the diagram.

- Borders: Sew **G** 2" borders around the quilt, sides first, then top and bottom borders. Next, sew **E** 2 1/2" borders in the same order.

6. Sew **I** 1 1/4" borders to one side of 4 **B** borders according to the diagram. Next, sew **SIDE** borders to the quilt. Sew a Pieced Block to each end of the top and bottom border, then sew both borders to the quilt.

7. Last, sew **E** 2 1/2" borders to the quilt, sides first, then top and bottom borders.



8. The quilt measures approximately 70" x 106". Make backing (**Fabric C**) at least 6" larger than the top. Layer and baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**) and enjoy!!
