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**Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.**

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - cut 2 - 18" x 24 1/2" (center design evenly)

**Fabric B** - cut the following borders lengthwise:

cut 2 - 7 1/2" x 20 1/2"

cut 2 - 3 3/4" x 42 1/2" (Sides)

**Fabric C** - cut 3 - 10 1/2" strips, sew end to end then

subcut 2 - 10 1/2" x 50"

**Fabric D** - cut 2 - 1 3/4" strips, subcut 2 - 1 3/4" x 24 1/2"

cut 1 - 4 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 4 1/2" x 20 1/2"

cut 8 - 2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip, then

subcut: 2 - 2" x 20 1/2", 2 - 2" x 68 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 56"

**Fabric E** - cut 2 - 1 3/4" strips, subcut 2 - 1 3/4" x 24 1/2"

cut 1 - 2" strip, subcut 2 - 2" x 20 1/2"

cut 1 - 4 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 4 1/2" x 20 1/2"

**Fabric F** - cut 11 - 2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long

strip, then subcut: 2 - 2" x 42 1/2", 2 - 2" x 50",

2 - 2" x 65 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 53"

**Fabric G** - Backing - piece backing to be approximately

56" x 71 1/2"

optional remote control pocket - cut 1 - 6" x 15"

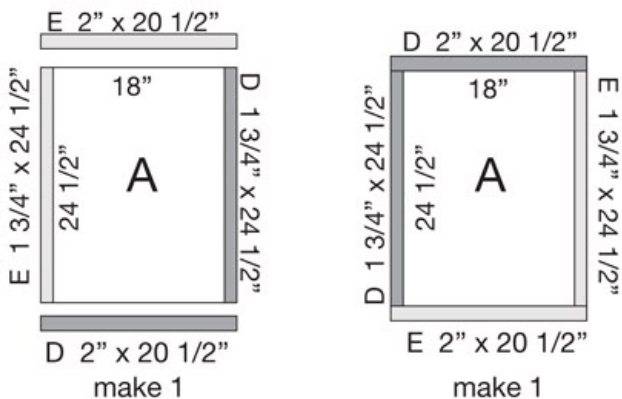
(size may be adjusted for specific remote controls)

**BATTING** - cut 1 approximately 56" x 71 1/2"

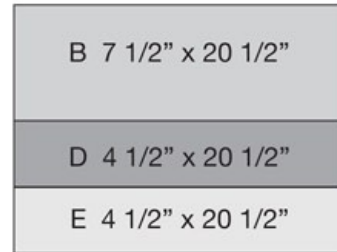
\*\* (cut batting and backing the exact size of YOUR completed top)

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **E** and **D** 1 3/4" x 24 1/2" borders to both SIDES of **A** 18" x 24 1/2". Next, sew **E** and **D** 2" x 20 1/2" to the TOP and BOTTOM according to the diagrams. Make 2 focal blocks that measure 20" x 27" finished (20 1/2" x 27 1/2" unf.) once bordered.



2. Next, sew two strip sets by sewing **B** 7 1/2" x 20 1/2", **D** 4 1/2" x 20 1/2" and **E** 4 1/2" x 20 1/2" strips side by side.

3. Sew one strip set below one **A** block and sew one strip set above the other **A** block. Then sew rows together for the quilt center according to the diagram on the next page.

4. Sew **F** 2" x 42 1/2" to both SIDES of the quilt center.

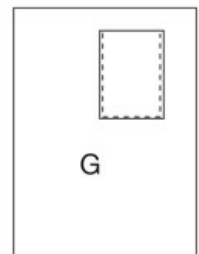
5. Sew **B** 3 3/4" x 42 1/2" to both SIDES of the quilt.

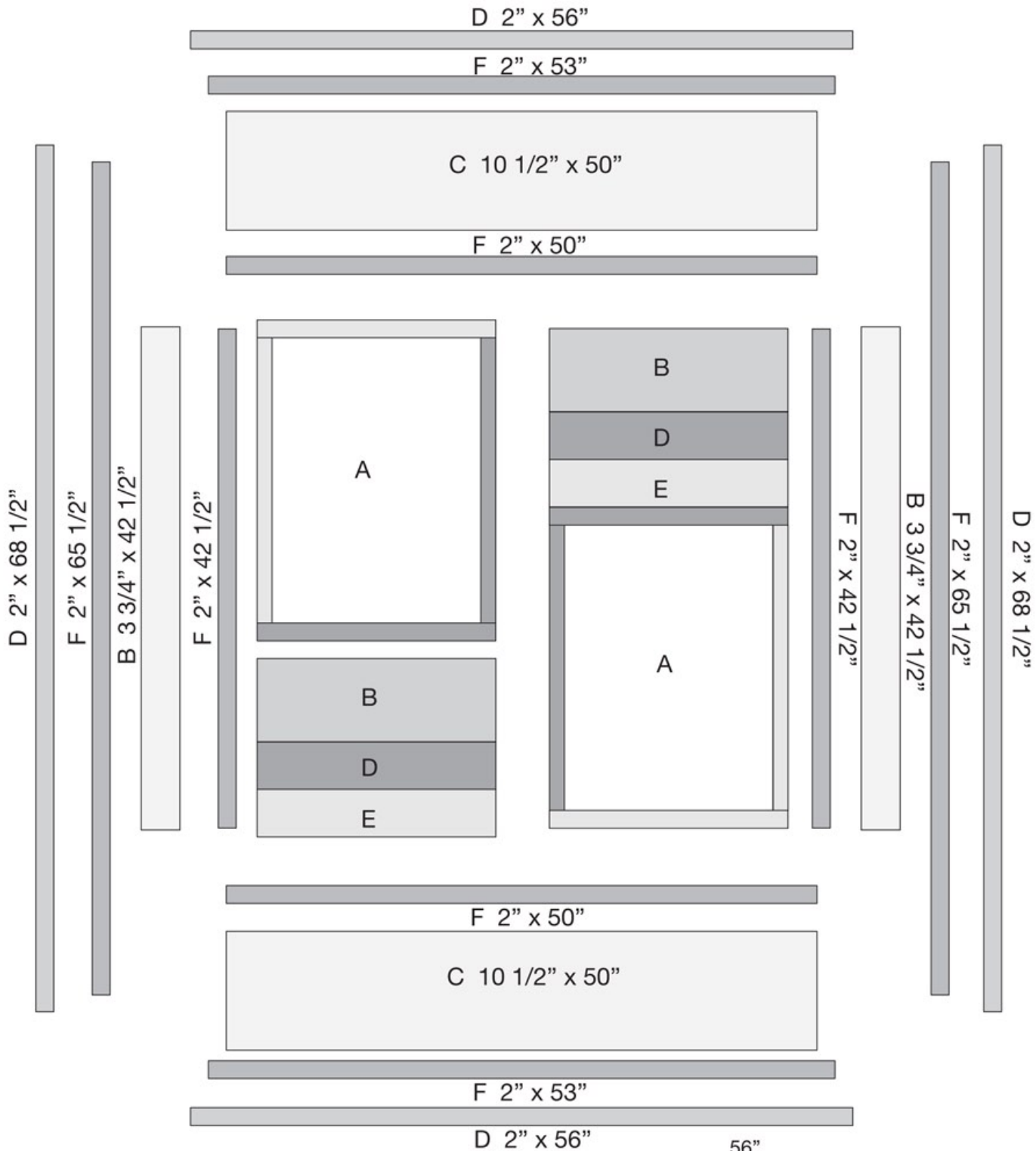
6. Sew **F** 2" x 50" and **C** 10 1/2" x 50" borders above and below quilt according to the diagram on the next page.

7. Sew **F** 2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.

8. Sew **D** 2" borders around quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.

9. Make optional remote control pocket by folding **G** 6" x 15" strip in half, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" around edge of pocket, leaving approximately 4" opening for turning. Clip corners and turn pocket right sides out. Press. Stitch opening closed. Pin pocket to the right side of backing (**Fabric G**) several inches from the TOP and SIDE. Topstitch pocket sides and bottom to the backing.





10. Finishing the quilt: Layer batting, quilt (right side up), backing (right side down). Match raw edges and secure with pins. Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " around edge of quilt, leaving approximately 12" opening for turning along one side. Clip corners and turn right sides out. Press. Stitch opening closed. Topstitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " around edge of quilt to create faux binding. Add optional quilting as desired (not over pocket) and enjoy!!
